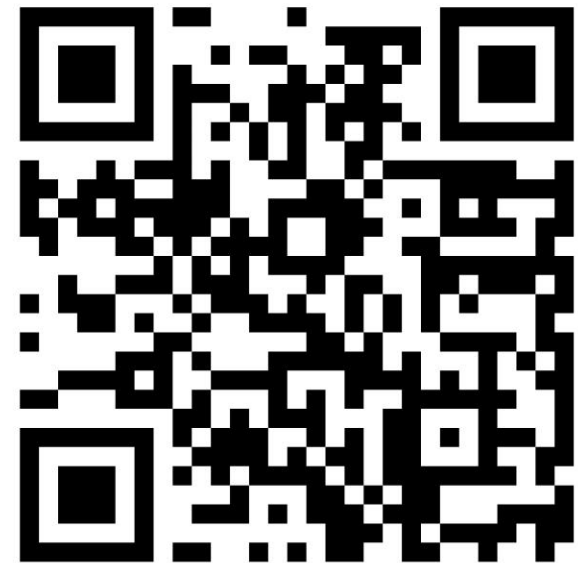

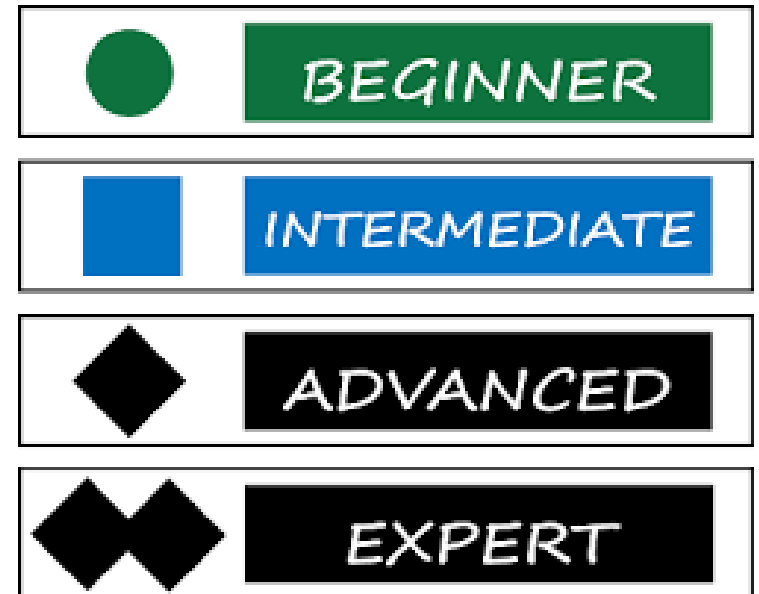

The Goal



The Opportunity – *It can be built*

- Land & Recurring Maintenance
 - TDRPD land grant in 2015
 - Regional Park Master Plan Approved Feb 2020
 - MOU w/ TDRPD 2024 outlines TDRPD responsibilities
 - 70% funding threshold established for construction start
- Permits
 - Approved by ToT – June 2022
 - 83 CoA's w/TDPUD, ToT & TDRPD agreements
 - 2yr Extension – ToT approved November 2024 through Dec 2026
 - Ground breaking needs to *start by Dec 2026*
- We need **Financial Support** to complete construction/site improvements

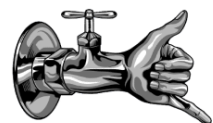

>\$190K in Costs covered by RMSP

- Skatepark Design & Construction Docs: ~\$70K
- ToT Permit Application process: ~\$65K
 - CEQA Mitigated Negative Declaration ~\$47K
- ToT CoA's – \$40K
- Community Events/Partnerships: \$20K
 - Including sponsoring TDRPD Sports and Music
 - TTUSD - Gone Boarding

Cost has Escalated *Dramatically*

- Skatepark Only – initial concept
 - **\$500K** - 2015 - estimate/guess provided with land grant
 - **\$900K** - 2018 - via landscape architect after public input
 - Zach Wormhoudt – Wormhoudt Inc / CA Skateparks
- Skatepark + Civil Improvements - required by ToT
 - **\$1.8M** - 2022 - \$1.2M skatepark + \$600K civil (curb/sidewalk/landscaping/wetland mitigation/parking)
 - Wormhoudt (skatepark) + Millenium Planning & Engineering (civil)
 - **\$2.3M** - 2024 January - \$1.6M skatepark + \$700K civil improvements – private funding, private management
 - Mill P&E + Bids from contractors

Total Project Cost – Public Bid

- **\$3.3M** – Full estimates from Spohn Ranch – Skatepark Builder
 - Retail. Skatepark. Civil. Prevailing Wage.
- Location is a blessing and a *curse*
 - TDPUD land on lease to TDRPD
 - ToT doesn't fund 'Recreation'
 - Adjacent to Wetlands
 - Multiple Projects: Library & Kidzone



TDRPD MOU – Feb 2024

Moved \$100K from Charity Smith and \$100K TMRF donation into TDRPD Accounts.



NOW THEREFORE, the Parties hereby enter into this MOU and agree to assume the following responsibilities:

- TDRPD will reserve the designated location for construction of the skate park until this initiative is complete or deemed infeasible or unlikely to be completed due to a lack of funding, expiration of project approvals, or other reasons as determined by TDRPD.

As a community, we need to account for 70% of the expected project budget

- ~\$2.3M needs to be 'on paper' before we can break ground.

for in-kind donations for the construction of the skate park.

- TDRPD will coordinate with Rocker on all grant applications and contractual agreements.
- Once 70% of the expected project budget has been secured – either raised through monetary donations or grant awards (held in bank or TDRPD reserve accounts) or through in-kind donations of materials/labor guaranteed by company promissory letters – and provided all COA items have been performed and deemed acceptable by TOT, all project approvals, including building permits, have been obtained and are in full force and effect, Rocker has transferred all cash donations for construction to TDRPD and confirmed all in-kind donations for construction TDRPD will commence with breaking ground and constructing the project, coordinating with Rocker and selected contractor(s).
- TDRPD is committed to owning, operational management and ongoing maintenance of the skate park once construction has been completed.

Either party may terminate this MOU upon notice to the other party if in its reasonable opinion it deems completion of the skate park infeasible or unlikely to be completed due to a lack of funding, expiration of project approvals, or other reasons.

Construction Funds held by TDRPD

- Total Raised to Date:
\$625,000
- Design/Permits/501c3 Expenses
-\$215,000
- Total held in Construction Funds
\$410,000

- Gap ...
\$1,900,000

How are we going to get there?

- In-kind Material / Labor Donations
 - Time to put it on paper, not only does it reduce total cost, but also management fees
 - We estimate up to **\$900,000** could be taken off the build costs ... possibly more.
 - That brings the Gap down to **\$1M**

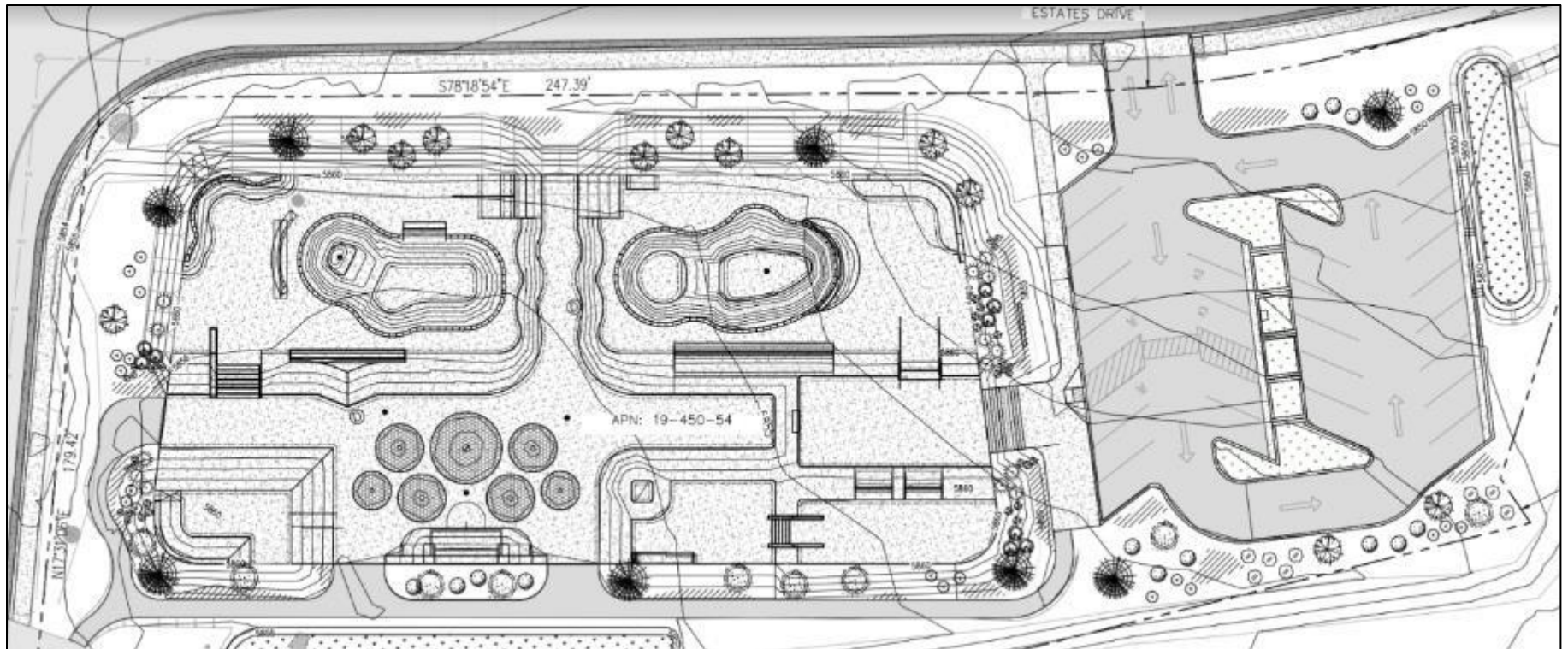

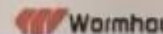

Rocker Memorial Skate Park

The existing Skate Park on the west side of Estates Drive in TRRP is over 20 years old. At 7,000 square feet, the facility is used to a point of overcrowding despite its lack of accommodations for skaters at the beginner and advanced levels. The Skate Park Group is looking to expand the Skate Park in an area closely adjoining the existing facility in order to provide more street and beginner areas and more deeps and bowls for expert skaters. They have identified a preferred location mirroring their existing location over to the east side of Estates Drive. This project is expected to be immediate.

Immediate Implementation Items (0-2 years)

1. Implement Community Pavilion & Ice Arena on the site of the current TDRPD maintenance yard.
 - Relocate disc golf holes disturbed by Community Pavilion & Ice Arena.
2. Implement the addition to Rocker Memorial Skate Park including associated parking lot and Estates Drive crossing improvements between Skate Parks.
3. Work with Town of Truckee to improve the Estates Drive intersection with the driveway to the school site and baseball parking lot.

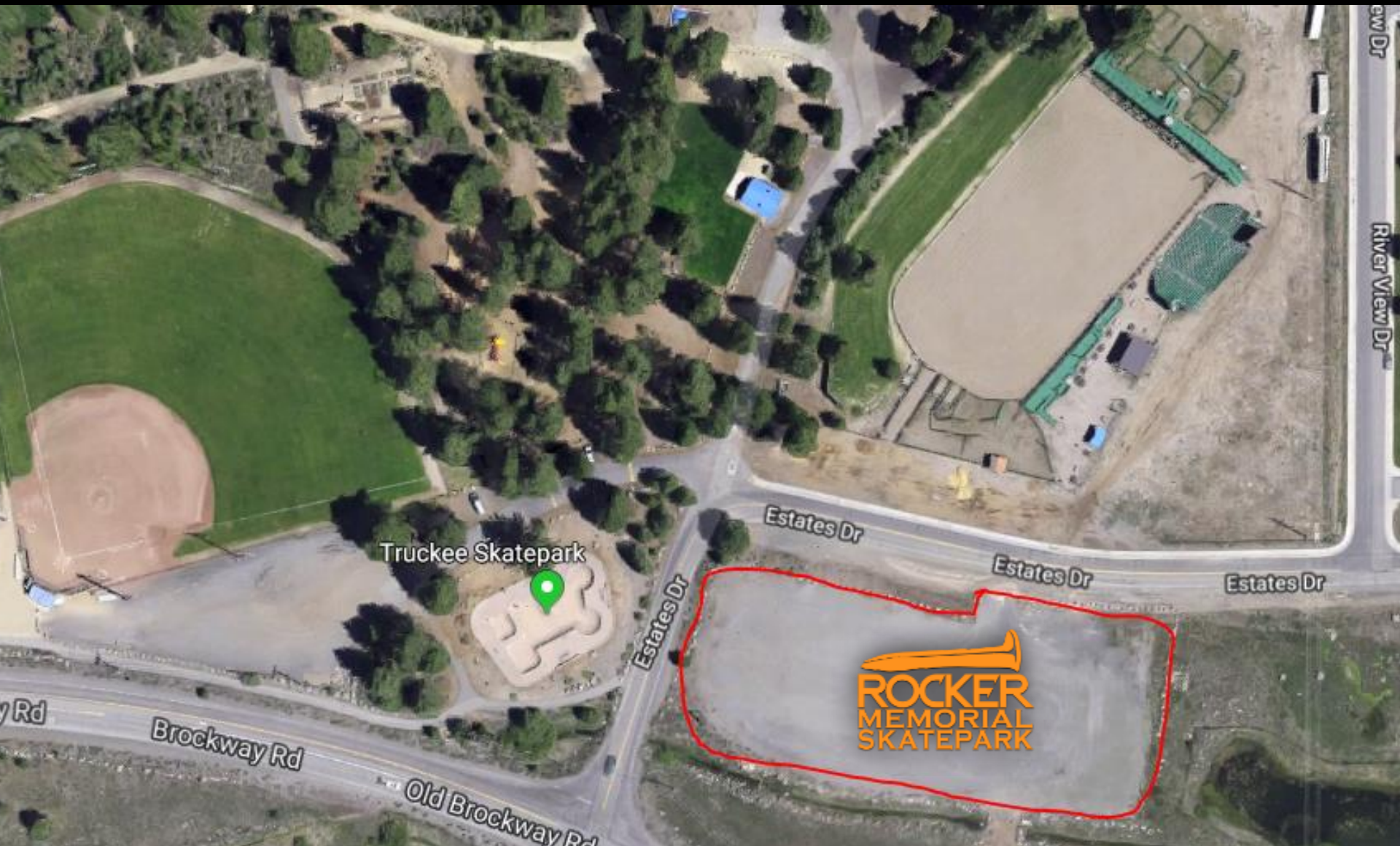
Rocker Memorial Skatepark

- Activates an underutilized area in a prime location
 - Sustainable facility will require very little maintenance
 - Easily accessible off the legacy trail system
 - Keeps cars off the roads locally
 - Beautifies the landscape, significantly improves ecologic impact of current vacant impervious lot
- Creates a 'World Class' facility in Truckee
 - Regional attraction – reduces Vehicle Miles Traveled to Reno/Sacramento

Community Benefits

- Free - All ages recreational outlet
 - Open sunup to sundown
- Provides positive safe social space
 - Alternative to 'team' sports
 - Fosters community – encourages diversity
 - a self-governing space managed by the stewardship of participants
 - Significant Health Benefits
 - Develops self-discipline, stamina and self-confidence
- Creates a public, interactive sculpture
